

GRANT DESCRIPTIONS



IDEAS GRANTS

- Up to the value of £10,000
- If you have a research idea you think could make a real impact
- Available for bursaries for undergraduates to undertake a research project
- Shortlisted applicants will be invited to take part in our '*Strictly Research*' event

SUPPORT FOR SAMPLE COLLECTION

- Up to the value of £15,000 depending on the number of patient samples collected by the centre
- Open to surgical centres to support the collection of patient samples and the use of these samples in high-quality research
- These grant are available for 3 years, however, continuation of funding will be reviewed yearly and will depend on the success of the previous year in collecting and sharing samples for research.

EXPLORER GRANTS

- Up to the value of £70,000
- If you have a research idea that needs further exploration
- If you need preliminary data to apply for a large grant

STUDENTSHIPS

- Up to the value of £170,000
- If you are committed to a career in primary bone cancer research but need the starting qualification (PhD/MD)
- The principle investigator or candidate may apply
- This grant is for up to 4 years of study

FELLOWSHIPS

- Up to the value of £400,000
- If you want to establish yourself as a leading bone cancer researcher
- To provide pilot data for larger funding applications
- Post-doctoral candidates
- The applicant must apply
- This grant is for up to 3 years of study

CLINICAL/TRANSLATIONAL

- Up to the value of £450,000
- These grants are aimed at research that is at the required point of development to be progressed from laboratory to patient.
