RESEARCH FUNDING REMIT

Bone Cancer Research Trust is dedicated to improving the outcomes for patients with primary bone cancer. One of the main ways in which we aim to do this, is by funding cutting edge research.

Our funding is dedicated to projects that are genuinely centered around improving knowledge of this disease, with a clear line of sight to patient benefit and with good prospects of being published in high impact journals.

We fund research in the UK, and the wider world where specified, and we strongly encourage both national and international collaborations.

We fund research into a wide variety of perspectives, including biological, translational, clinical, epidemiological, psycho-social and health services research, however, prioritise research into the cure and causes – as suggested by our patients and stakeholders. Funding will be awarded to projects looking at any form of Primary Bone Cancer, such as Osteosarcoma, Ewing Sarcoma, Chondrosarcoma and Chordoma. Funding will be provided for research into rarer types of Primary Bone Cancer, such as Angiosarcoma of the bone, Spindle Cell Sarcoma, Adamantinoma and Giant Cell Tumour of the Bone, however, we do not fund research into non-malignant bone tumours, such as Ameloblastoma and cannot fund research into secondary bone cancers.
