## **Time Commitment**

3-4 hours between 10.30am – 5.00pm

*\*If you can't commit to 3-4 hours, we would still be interested in hearing from you!*

## **Location**

You will be based at one of our cheer points:

For the TCS London Marathon these are:

- Cheer Point 1 – Shadwell (mile 13 & 21): the cheer point will be located in front of St George's Leisure centre on the same side of the road. It is a 5 minute walk from Shadwell Station.
- Cheer Point 2 – Westminster (mile 25): the cheer point will be located in front of Big Ben on the same side of the road. It is easily accessible via Exit 3 from Westminster Underground Station.

For London Landmarks Half Marathon this are:

- Outside Hamilton House on the same side of the road. It is a 7 minute walk from Blackfriars station.

There will be large crowds so you will need to position yourself in the best location to capture the shots/footage. We will have a team cheering for our runners so it's a great opportunity to capture the runners' reactions as they approach the cheer point.

We understand that with the sheer volume of participants it is not always possible to spot all our runners but our staff will do their best to point people out to you. Any photos of our cheer point, branding, and supporters would also be great. Our cheer point will be branded with orange flags and banners and our runners will be wearing bright orange running tops:

## **Expenses**

The Bone Cancer Research Trust will cover reasonable travel expenses within Greater London. Volunteers should retain any travel and parking receipts to be submitted alongside an expenses claim form following the event.

## **Equipment**

We ask you to use your own camera and filming equipment. You must take responsibility for the security and safekeeping of your equipment during the event.

## **Clothing**

We will provide you with a Bone Cancer Research Trust hoodie or t-shirt on the day so that you stand out to our runners.

## **Responsibility**

Volunteers will be representing the Bone Cancer Research Trust on the day of the event, and we ask that you conduct yourselves in a professional manner at all times.
